

# INFORMATION ON ADMISSION MA IN INTERNATIONAL WATER GOVERNANCE AND WATER DIPLOMACY UNIVERSTITY OF PUBLIC SERVICE, BUDAPEST, HUNGARY 2020-2022

The University of Public Service of Hungary launches a Master of Arts programme in International Water Governance and Water Diplomacy for the academic years of 2020-2022. This document contains information on the programme and the application process.

#### **Outline of the MA programme**

The two year (four semester) MA programme comprises five broad knowledge clusters as follows:

- General questions of water management
- Introduction to water governance and conflict management
- Water law
- International water governance
- Water diplomacy and international conflict management.

## Who can apply?

Any student with a bachelor (or graduate) degree in **political science**, **law**, **international relations**, **economics**, **water or environmental management/engineering** with a professional command of **English** can apply for the MA programme. Given the broad scope of the curriculum **no specific prior studies**, professional experience, etc. is **required** in any discipline related to water or diplomacy.

## **Conditions of application**

The conditions of application are

- bachelor or graduate degree in political science, law, international relations, economics, water or environmental management/engineering
- proof of language **English** proficiency (level B2<sup>1</sup>).

English language proficiency can be demonstrated by:

- any recognised English language test certificate (IELTS, TOEFL etc.) or
- college degree in English.

Applicants of **Hungarian citizenship** must follow the centralised application process through www.felvi.hu.

Non-Hungarian nationals:

- attach a photocopy of your relevant **degree**, your **language certificate** and **passport**.

Submission of your application will be confirmed immediately.

### **Deadline for application**

The deadline for application is 15 May 2020.

#### **Tuition fees**

Tuition fees:

- for full time students: **HUF 285 000**/semester (ca. 950 USD)
- part time students: **HUF 265 000**/semester (ca. 900 USD)

### **Scholarships**

For the academic year 2020-2021 the MA programme does not qualify for the government scholarship scheme for foreign students (Stipendium Hungaricum). Hungarian nationals are eligible for a public service scholarship in a limited number.

#### Visa requirements

For non-European Union nationals participation in the MA programme is subject to an appropriate **visa**. Confirmation of admission issued by University of Public Service is a precondition for a student visa application, but does not guarantee the actual issuance of a visa.
